### Oilex Ltd - Trading Halt Request

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1 Oilex Ltd (ASX: OEX, AIM: OEX) hereby requests an immediate trading halt on the Company's securities from 7am AWST on Friday, 2 November 2018.


In accordance with Listing Rule 17.1, Oilex provides the following information:

- a) Further to the announcement made yesterday on 1 November 2018 in relation to the High Court of Gujarat (Court), India, rendering a judgement, the Company has requested a full written copy of the judgement from the Court which is anticipated to be received later today (IST).
- b) Pending an announcement by the Company providing an update on the decision of the Court, Oilex requests the trading halt to remain in place until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market in relation to the decision of the Court and the commencement of trading on Tuesday 6 November 2018; and
- c) Oilex is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
